## Rules & Regulations

Rules & procedures of the NSSA will be observed during this registered shoot. Management, and/or the Shoot Committee reserves the right to alter the program according to NSSA rules, if deemed required for the smooth operation of the shoot.

It is the shooter's responsibility to have his classification card up-to-date prior to presenting it at the registration desk.

**AMMUNITION:** All popular brands of factory ammunition will be available at the Detroit Gun Club. Reloads may be used and are subject to inspection. Participants are not allowed to pick up spent hulls from the grounds during or after the shoot.

**PROTEST:** Any protest of a referee's decision must be made before the contestant moves to the next station. A Protest Committee will be formed from nationally recognized shooters in attendance, and their names will be posted at the registration desk. The Protest Committee will rule on all protests, except those judgment calls ruled on by the field referee.

**SCORES:** All score sheets **must** be signed by a squad member before leaving the field. Scores will be posted by shoot management as soon as possible after each squad has finished shooting. Shooters are responsible to the scorekeeper to verify classes entered and scores shot. Scores become final (5) minutes prior to the shoot-offs in that event.

**OPEN OR OUT!!!:** All guns must be carried with the breech open except when on the shooting station. Safety demands that this rule be strictly adhered to while on the shooting fields and when going about the clubs grounds.

**FOR SAFETY'S SAKE:** The NSSA rule requiring eye & ear protection for all participants, and those spectators adjacent to the shooting fields, will be strictly observed.

**FLIGHT TIMES: One hour & 20 minutes!** This shoot will run on time. No exceptions.

**SQUAD TIMES WILL NOT BE ANNOUNCED. BE READY!** Each squad will be on the field as scheduled. Any squad or shooter not ready to shoot as scheduled will be dropped to the bottom of the entry list, and may not be able to finish the event. There will be no refunds in such cases. Slow squads will be moved to the practice field. No exceptions!
