

## Michigan Skeet Association Club of the Year

Each year three member clubs are recognized for their support to the MSA through their shooting events and programs. Club rankings are determined using five metrics, which are:

1. Total number of targets thrown in the most recent shooting year (Zone, State, SCTP and other event targets, as determined by the MSA Board, such as the U.S. Open iShoot targets are excluded).
2. Increase/decrease in targets thrown comparing the most recent shooting year with the previous year.
3. Percentage increase/decrease in targets thrown comparing the most recent shooting year with the previous year.
4. Number of "qualifying" events held at each club. "Targets only", league, Zone shoot, State shoot and SCTP events do not qualify for inclusion. Also, other events, as determined by the MSA Board, such as the U.S. Open iShoot, are excluded.
5. Junior participation based upon the total number of "Junior" targets thrown during the most recent shooting year.

Clubs are ranked from high (best performing) to low in each category. The number of possible points received is based on the number of clubs hosting events in the most recent year. For example, if there are 15 member clubs, then "points" are awarded from 15 down to one in each category. A club's final ranking is determined by adding up the points in each category. The club with the highest total is the 1<sup>st</sup> Place MSA Club of the Year; the next highest, is the 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Club of the Year; and, the third highest, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place.

For the 2023 MSA Club of the Year, 2022 is the "most recent" shooting year, and 2021 the "previous" shooting year.
