

2022 Michigan Buckle Race

- All MSA members in good standing are eligible to participate. MSA will provide awards for each Buckle Race shoot, as well as, Belt Buckles for the overall winners and place finishers.
- The Buckle Race will consist of four (4) events with the Michigan State Shoot being mandatory and the final event. Awards will be given at the State Shoot. Shooters can pick any Buckle Race shoots during the year to make up their remaining three (3) events. Shooters can participate in as many eligible events as they wish, and their top three (3) events will count towards their final score (1,600 targets) ... remember the State Shoot will be the fourth event and is mandatory.
- Shooter's HOA will be established at the beginning of the 2022 shoot year based on the HOA tables in the NSSA Rules book. An unclassified shooter's HOA will be determined after the first five (5) registered events as detailed in NSSA Rules book. The shooters HOA will determine which division they are in.
- There will be two (2) HOA divisions:
 - ❖ Michigan Division: AAA, AA & A (HOA .9388 and over)
 - ❖ Huron Division: B, C D & E (HOA under .9388)
- Race begins April 1st and ends at the Michigan State Shoot in August.
- Handicap targets will be added to each HOA score as follows:
 - ❖ Michigan Division – AA shooters will get two (2) and A class shooters four (4) targets added to each HOA score they record.
 - ❖ Huron Division – C class shooters will get five (5), D class shooters ten (10) and E class shooters fifteen (15) targets added to each HOA score they record.
- Scores for the race will be the shooter's HOA score from each Buckle Race event – HOA score to consist of 12g, 20g, 28g & .410 bore – 100 targets each gauge, 400 targets total per event. The Buckle Race will consist of a total of 1,600 targets (4 events x 400 targets).
- There will be nine (9) weekends for elective events, with one weekend having multiple events.
- Buckle race schedule will be posted on MSA website.
- There will be no cost for shooters to participate.
- There will be a special division for SCTP shooters. The SCTP shooter race will be only one (1) gun vs four (4) guns. SCTP scores posted from Buckle Race events will count towards their total and the State Shoot is a mandatory event for them as well – only 12g events will be counted towards their total. SCTP shooter will have to declare which Race (i.e., "Open HOA" or 12 Gauge SCTP) they are competing in -- can't be in both. There is a separate flyer for SCTP shooters, with additional details, be posted on MSA website.

What are you shooting for????

- MSA will provide awards for each Buckle Race shoot for the HOA CH, RU, 3rd and Class 1st winners.
- Championship Awards will be a handsome belt buckle – 1st, 2nd & 3rd place in each Open HOA division; 1st & 2nd place in SCTP 12 Gauge division. Any ties will be shot-off at the State Shoot.
- A \$500 college/trade school scholarship will be awarded to the SCTP winner as follows:
 - ❖ 1st - \$ 300
 - ❖ 2nd - \$200
